Action Shots Photo Contest Instructions

Step 1.

Take a photo of you or your fellow JCI members taking action. While this may sound simple, getting a great photo takes careful planning and a keen eye for detail. By following the steps below, you can ensure your photos will capture the essence of the JCI Impact:

- 1. Choose compelling photo subjects performing an obvious action.
- 2. Select a scene that provides a context for the actions being taken.
- 3. Keep both eyes open while shooting and pay attention to the environment around your photo.
- 4. Shoot with your back to the sun or source of light to ensure your subjects are properly lit.
- 5. Shoot naturally occurring interactions posing for photos is fun, but it does not convey action.
- 6. Shoot more pictures than you need, because you can always pick the best one and edit it later.
- 7. Don't disturb the event in progress just to get a good photo. Remember, the action being taken is the important part.

Step 2.

Create an account on Flickr. If you already have a Yahoo! account, you may login with your Yahoo! user name and password. If not, click on the link below and follow the instructions.

After signing in with your account, click "Upload" at the top of the screen, or click on the link below.

Click "Choose Photos and Videos" and select up to five photos you want to submit for the JCI Action Shots Contest. Make sure the "Public" option is selected and click "Upload Photos and Videos." In just a few minutes, your photos will be uploaded to your own Flickr page.
